### The BECA Foundation Receives Initial Funding to Implement The Project Bridge

[www.TheProjectBridge.org](http://www.TheProjectBridge.org) is the latest project of The BECA Foundation following close on the heels of the organization's most recent launch of an expanded city-wide installment of the emerging art + design exhibition, **CURATE THIS!** The next exhibition installment is slated to open July 1, 2010 in Denver, CO, USA in conjunction with the **Denver Biennial of the Americas**.

The Project Bridge is an online avenue where creative projects being developed around the world are offered a bridge to fruition. Creative producers submit their one page project proposals seeking funding, support services, space usage, equipment, collaborative partners, etc. and if selected for upload, the project proposal is presented on The Project Bridge website. Via [www.TheProjectBridge.org](http://www.TheProjectBridge.org), visitors, potential collaborators and supporters may view a wide variety of creative projects that are in need of various resources and are at various stages of development. Projects will be initially sorted by city, state, province, country and later by discipline. Supporters and collaborators can then connect with nearby projects or they may seek out projects half way around the world.

The BECA Foundation wanted to launch The Project Bridge early into the development of **CURATE THIS! 2010 – DENVER** so that participating artists + designers could begin to connect with early supporters for their projects. Simultaneously, The BECA Foundation wanted to make the site available to as many creative producers as need be on a global level.

Project proposals that have been submitted for preview thus far have included proposals for:

- community theatre productions
- a parade to raise awareness of environmental issues
- site-specific art installations
- the launch of a new magazine
- creating a line of human paper-doll fashion
- the publication of both fiction and non-fiction books
- creating/completing documentary films and shorts
- creating music and sound recordings
- developing eco-product designs
- capturing a video diary
